THAI CONVERSATION BASICS

These are SO IMPORTANT... Even just being able to speak a few words in Thai will help you build relationships and open doors for the Gospel. If you've never formally studied Thai, try practicing these basic sayings before your trip. You can also look online for Thai resources and tutorials.

For males, end expressions with KRAP. For females end in KHA

- 1. Hello: Sa-wad-dee krap/kha (สวัสดี)
- 2. Thank you: Kha-pun krap/kha (ขอขอบคุณ)
- 3. How are you? Sa-bai-dee-mai krap/kha? (สบายดีใหม?)
- 4. God loves you: Phra-chao-rak-khun (พระเจ้ารักคุณ)
- 5. Jesus loves you: Phra-yea-su-rak-khun (พระเยซูรักคุณ)
- 6. What is your name? Khun-chew-a-rai krap/kha? (คุณชื่ออะไร?)
- 7. Where is the bathroom? Hong-nam-you-thi-nai **krap/kha?** (ห้องน้ำอยู่ที่ใหน?)
- 8. I don't speak Thai: Pom poot-tai-mai-dai krap/kha. (ผมพูดไทยไม่ได้)
- 9. Excuse me: Kho-thot- krap/kha (ขอโทษ)
- 10. God bless you: Phra-chao-way-pon krap/kha (ขอให้พระเจ้าคุ้มครอง)
